	27 th April		<p>captured 300 yards of trench but that they had been ejected in half-an-hour. At 12.30 pm Lt Leving with 5 Bombers went out and bombed the enemy's posts at Suffolk Crater. The crater was strongly held and a good bomb fight resulted as rifle grenades were covering the party. The enemy fired his machine guns and put up 2 red star shells. We suffered no casualties.</p>	
	28 th		<p>Heat still continues. Enemy's Artillery has been active registering on reserve trenches. A further gas alarm was raised in the evening which turned out to be without foundation. Heavy firing was heard in the South.</p>	
	29 th		<p>Harley Street was heavily shelled during the evening and several direct hits obtained on the Field Ambulance Station. At 10 pm a pre-arranged bombardment of the enemy's front line and Crater's commenced. Troops were withdrawn from our front line and a good deal of damage done to the hostile trenches. Sgt McEwan was slightly wounded in the hand by a fragment of shell.</p>
